


About the project:



Let's build birds and create a fun sky in our windows!







Creative Challenge

Follow the "First step" and "Family friendly" instructions. Before gluing your pieces, add more details to them. Personalise your birds. You can even add cut straps from old fabrics or clothes.

Why do not repeat that on both sides ?!






Inner artist

Create your own birds, still using your hands as templates.
Shape the rest of the body yourself.

Observe birds, make some research about them and be inspired! Paint, add details, glue materials on both sides. You can even stich, cut, fold your recycled carton.




Last step!

Well done! You can now think about how you will display your bird(s) on your window.

For example, you can make a tiny hole and use the string provided to hang your bird, use a thin pin in your ceiling.







We are inviting you to make a pair of birds with you both hands as templates (add a beak!) to add to our shop window display to show that together we make a community. Please use a blue paint background on both sides.
